## SERVICE UPDATE

**COUNSELLING:** Self referrals for counselling are currently being accepted for remote support only - Monday-Friday between 11am and 5pm. This service is being delivered by our friendly, trained counsellors.

**ESPRESSO YOURSELF CAFÉ:** Drop-ins are available Mondays & Fridays 4-8pm. During lockdown we're not offering group activities or peer support but young people can access 1:1 support with a support worker. This service is for 11-18 year olds, their parents and carers. **WELLBEING SESSIONS:** Remote wellbeing sessions are available every Saturday between 1pm and 3pm and every Wednesday between 5pm and 7pm using either video call or telephone.
